

Will Coinbase refund money if I was scammed? Cb~Refund

○ 1-(816)(208)(7304) When someone tricks you into sending crypto on Coinbase 1-(816)(208)(7304), don't expect the exchange to give you your money back. That's because crypto transactions are final and can't be reversed.

A big part of the scam is to fool the victim into sending money to the scammer's wallet willingly. So 1-(816)(208)(7304), since you are the one who sent the crypto 1-(816)(208)(7304), there's no way Coinbase can reverse it. Coinbase refunds extremely rare cases even if you tell and explain the situation.

Still 1-(816)(208)(7304), Coinbase will welcome you to file a report about the scam 1-(816)(208)(7304), and probably provide you with instructions to secure your account and report the incident to the police. In case a scam is a part of a bigger pattern 1-(816)(208)(7304), Coinbase can inform other users about it by issuing a warning. How do I claim a refund after a crypto scam on Coinbase? Claim-Refund

In case you have been scammed 1-(816)(208)(7304), you are able to report the situation to Coinbase 1-(816)(208)(7304), however 1-(816)(208)(7304), you very likely cannot claim your refund. The first step is to visit an online Support  1-(816)(208)(7304) page at Coinbase 1-(816)(208)(7304), and make a ticket with your version of the scam.
